

FAQ's.....About CYSA – Cal Soccer League (aka CCSL)

1. Where do we find information about (CYSA-Cal Soccer League) CCSL Playing League?

2. What age groups are committed to participate in the CCSL from district VI?

A. *The District VI League presidents voted to have all U-9 to U-12 Division 1 and Division 3 boys and girls teams join the CCSL for the 2010-2011 season. Any other age group team may participate if they wish as long as there is a division in which for them to play.*

3. Who will administer the CCSL playing divisions?

A. *CYSA through the CCSL Playing League will administer the Gold and above divisions. District VI through the existing Metro administration will administer Silver Divisions and below using the same successful management team currently in place for District VI.*

4. What is cost to play in CCSL League?

A. *The cost for the application is \$135.00 per team. All other associated costs for running teams are what they have historically been on a team by team basis.*

5. Are we required to change our classification from Division 3 status to Division 1 status to join this league?

A. *No.*

6. What tournaments can we play in?

A. *Division 3 teams may continue to play in Division 3 tournaments and Association Cup. You could also play in State Cup as a Division 3 team.*

7. Can Division 1 teams play in Division 3 tournaments?

A. *No. And Division 1 teams cannot play in District Cup or Association Cup either.*

8. Will there be seeding tournaments for U-12 and below teams?

A. *Yes. All teams bronze and below will continue to have seeding tournaments. Gold teams will be seeded by the state playing league. Silver teams may be seeded by state if the participation numbers are high enough. Otherwise District VI will seed.*

9. Will we have to travel outside District VI boundaries to play in CCSL league?

A. *It is the intent that we have our District VI teams play within our boundaries. Gold and Silver teams may play teams from Districts 5 or 9, but negotiations are currently underway to have midway locations all be in District VI boundaries. Bronze teams and below will more than likely play within District VI boundaries, but there could be exceptions. Teams participating in age groups above U-12 may have to travel outside District VI boundaries and this should be taken into consideration before applying.*

10. Under what rules will our current Metro teams play?

A. *It is the intent of District VI Metro Division to operate under both current District VI Metro rules and in concert with CCSL rules for all Division 3 teams. Division 1 teams will operate under CCSL rules.*
